## Port of Illahee – Minutes of Regular Meeting on January 12, 2022

### Port of Illahee Minutes of Regular Meeting January 12, 2022

The Regular Port of Illahee meeting was held virtually through the ZOOM app (meeting id# 71509975823 / Password: Illahee). Notice of the virtual meeting was posted on the Port's website – portofillahee.com.

#### CALL TO ORDER

Commission Chairman James Aho called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. Also, in attendance were Commissioner Amber Bartz; Commissioner John Burton; Administrator Theresa Haaland was sick, but opened the Zoom account so the meeting could proceed; Jon Buesch, Richard Martinez with Kitsap Bank, Cathy Johnson; John Parvis, Roy Barton, Don Jahaske, Janet Soderberg, and Owen Crouse who joined us from Austin Texas.

#### CONSENT AGENDA

*Commissioner Burton moved to approve the consent agenda items: January Meeting Agenda; December 8, 2021 Regular Meeting minutes; Interim Approval of outstanding bills for the month contingent upon their approval by the Port Auditor and the Commissioners as indicated by the signing of the Voucher Approval document; second by Commissioner Bartz; approved unanimously.*

#### SIGNING OF DOCUMENTS

With the Port Administrator out sick, the Commissioners agreed to come in to the Port of Silverdale office to sign the documents when they are ready.

#### ELECTION OF OFFICERS/JOB DUTIES

Commissioners voted to maintain the previous officer assignments with Commissioner Aho serving as Chairman/Auditor/Webmaster; Commissioner Burton serving as Secretary/Dock Manager; and Commissioner Bartz serving as Property Manager. It was noted that Ken Bagwell is the Port Attorney.

#### PUBLIC COMMENT – None

#### REPORTS/UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Loan/Line-of-Credit – Updated Term Letter was signed – Attorney Cynthia Weed with K&L Gates was contacted to draw up the necessary Resolution, Port Attorney Ken Bagwell was asked to review the Resolution.

Bond Resolution 2022-01 - Richard Martinez of Kitsap Bank was introduced by former Port of Illahee Commissioner Jon Buesch. Richard explained the Limited Tax General Obligation Bond and its implications for the Port and answered questions from the Commissioners, followed by questions from the attendees. Following the Q&A session Commissioner Burton moved to approve Resolution 2022-01, seconded by Commissioner Bartz, and the Resolution was approved unanimously.

#### Grants/Waterfront Access Improvements –

Commissioner Aho reported that he talked with John Piccone this afternoon and that they are catching up after being caught in the winter storm in the Seabeck area that affected their power and ability to leave their residence. They are receiving input from the DCD planners on the shoreline permit and will be able to provide information to the Commissioners soon. Commissioner Aho noted Mr. Piccone is planning to brief the

Commissioners at least by the February meeting.

Treasurer's Report

As of December 31, 2021 the General Fund totaled \$109,234.72, Investments totaled \$277,220.45 and the balance of the Good Property Management (GPM) account totaled \$200.00 for a total of \$386,655.17.

Reports

Website – Commissioner Aho reported that while he was able to obtain a disk of the Surface Water Management Plan (SWMP) there were problems, and he was unable to post it to the website.

Properties

5560 Ocean View Boulevard/Rental Property – It has been suggested that we increase the insurance coverage to a minimum of \$650,000, and maximum of \$700,000; in case of damage and the need to rebuild due to increasing property values, and labor and material costs. It was agreed the insurance coverage should be increased to \$650,000.

Good Property Management (GPM) is working with the renters regarding a septic blockage that incurred a \$1,300 bill. Renters are liable. The renters have refused to sign an annual lease, GPM has locked the renters into a month-to-month lease that is legally binding.

5500 Illahee Road/Rental Property – nothing to report.

5507 Illahee Road/Illahee Store Property – Commissioner Aho explained that the Pollution Liability Insurance Agency (PLIA) will be contacted once we know what the store plans are.

Dock/Pier – Commissioner Burton reported that there wasn't much to report especially since the weather has been snowy and cold.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Commissioner Aho noted that Resolution 2022-02, the setting of the 2022 meeting calendar will be approved at the February Port meeting.

**PUBLIC COMMENT** – Janet Soderberg asked if there was going to be a cross walk from the store to the dock area and noted the traffic and the speeds of the vehicles. Commissioner Aho noted he is also concerned as he walks that area nearly every day and understands the issues. Owen Crouse expressed an interest in attending the All Ports meeting on January 31 and wondered how he would be able to attend via Zoom. Commissioner Aho noted that when he updates the website, he can add the Zoom meeting link.

*At 8:00 PM Commissioner Bartz moved to adjourn the meeting; second by Commissioner Burton; approved unanimously.*



All opinion letters are based on an analysis of whether the remedial action meets the substantive requirements of MTCA, Chapter 70.105D RCW, and implementing regulations, Chapter 173-340 WAC (collectively "substantive requirements of MTCA").

**The fee for this program is \$7,500.00. By signing this form, you agree to use \$7,500.00 of your Loan and Grant Program funds to pay the PTAP fee.**

### **Project Termination**

This Agreement may be terminated by either party without cause by sending written notice to the other party. The effective date of termination will be the date PLIA sends notice to the Customer or the date PLIA receives notice from the Customer. Unless otherwise directed, issuance of a No Further Action opinion, either for the Site as a whole or for a portion of the real property located within the Site, shall constitute notice of termination by PLIA.

### **Reservation of Rights/No Settlement**

This agreement does not constitute a settlement of liability to the state under MTCA. This Agreement also does not protect a liable person from contribution claims by third parties for matters addressed by the agreement. The state does not have the authority to settle with any person potentially liable under MTCA except in accordance with RCW 70.105D.040(4).

PLIA reserves all rights under MTCA, including the right to require additional or different remedial actions at the Site should it deem such actions necessary to protect human health and the environment, and to issue orders requiring such remedial actions.

### **Liability**

The state of Washington, PLIA, and its officers and employees are immune from all liability, and no cause of action arises from any act or omission in providing, or failing to provide, advice, opinion, conclusion, or assistance under this program.
